Nomination Eligibility:

- They should demonstrate a strong dedication to peace work and effectively share their ideas and insights with other communities.
- Their tireless efforts should significantly impact local communities for peace and development.
- Eligibility is restricted to individuals; team nominations are not accepted.
- Nominees must hold Nepalese citizenship.
- An individual can only receive this award once in their lifetime.
- We are happy if person/awardees will present Physically at the award ceremony.

The nomination package must encompass:

Mandatory: Signed Nomination Form.

Mandatory: Candidate's resume/profile, action-oriented photographs (minimum of three), a 1-2-minute video **if available** and any news coverage.

Mandatory: Letters of recommendation from a relevant organization/network or the respective local office.

Optional: Additional supporting documents deemed suitable.

All nomination materials should be received by September 8th, 2023, for consideration in this year's award.

Acknowledgments will be issued for all nominations, and records will be retained for two years. An expert panel of judges, following the MGDPA Award guidelines, will conduct a thorough assessment and interviews, and conclude the announcement of the winner by September 21, 2023."
